FIATA, the international federation of the national logistics & freight associations, headquartered in Zurich was founded in 1926, it is the world's largest non-governmental organization (NGO) in the field of international freight logistics & transportation. It has over 125-member countries and represents around 50,000 international logistics companies employing approximately 10 million people across 150 countries.

FIATA's general assembly meeting was held on October 8th 2017 during its World Congress 2017 being held this year in Kuala Lumpur. It is with pleasure that we inform you that Pakistan's national logistics association PIFFA's Founder Chairman Babar Badat has been elected the "President of FIATA".
